## RIGHTS RESPECTING



**Article 13:** (freedom of expression) Every child must be free to express their thoughts and opinions and to access all kinds of information, as long as it is within the law.

Online Safety - Bullying Online: Last week was anti-bullying week and the children discussed the question - Is banter ever an excuse for bullying? Online chatrooms and message boards are another place where bullying is disguised as banter. Some feel free to make comments either about a person in the chat room or outside. The intention is to make others laugh, but the harmful effects on the person being written about are not considered. Often these comments do not remain online and the victim is made aware by those who have seen the comments.

Some games let players turn off communications features, mute voice chat and report other players who behave inappropriately. Look at the settings available to see what's best for your child. Please monitor your child's use of these apps, and discuss the impact of unkind posts and messages, so they are ready to use social media in a respectful manner at an appropriate age.
