

Year 4 Autumn 2022 Theme: Make Peace, Not War!



We are learning how conflict has changed over time, why people go to war and the impact of war.

We will look at how conflict has changed from the Anglo-Saxons to modern day. We will focus on WWI, WWII and study the Battle of Britain and the Blitz in detail. As readers, we will read accounts and poems from soldiers from around the world and explore the lives of soldiers across the British Empire. Our class text will be *Goodnight Mr Tom*.

As writers, we will write diary entries and fictional stories based on war.
As artists, we will study Henry Moore and Charles Alston.

We will kick start our topic with our Stunning Start. The morning will be spent exploring Anglo-Saxon invasions and battles; following that we will role play different conflict scenarios, as world leaders!

During this term we hope to make a visit to Redbridge Museum in November and will welcome the Freshwater Theatre Company on the 19th September. Each class will take part in a WWII workshop.
